

2011-2012 CASFM/UWRI Scholarship Application

The Urban Watersheds Research Institute (UWRI) has made **\$2500** available to the Colorado Association of Stormwater and Floodplain Managers (CASFM) to award to students for the **2011-2012 academic year**. Application packages must be received by **November 28, 2011**.

Scholarship Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage sophomore and junior undergraduate civil engineering students to continue their education. Applicants must be enrolled in an ABET accredited undergraduate civil engineering program at a College or University in the State of Colorado and be registered to take at least 12 credit-hours of coursework per semester (full-time). Students must be in either their Sophomore or Junior year. Minimum GPA for consideration is 2.0/4.0. For more information about UWRI, please visit their website at www.urbanwatersheds.org. The scholarship recipient will also have the option to attend the 2011 annual CASFM conference held in September in Steamboat Springs, Colorado. Selection Process: Three applicants will be short-listed based on this application and a **short essay** (up to 500 words; attach to application) describing their personal and career goals and how winning this scholarship will help them achieve those goals. Short-listed applicants will be notified by **December 9th**. A panel will hold a short (approximately 20 minute) interview with short-listed applicants in mid-December at the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District office in Denver. The successful candidate will be notified by **December 23rd**. Funds will be disbursed by check directly to the student.
