This year's bike tour should be a fun and educational event, with much less straight up and straight down than year's past. We will get a first hand look at the river stabilization along the Colorado River through Glenwood Canyon. So if you need a break from the indoor presentations Thursday afternoon, please join us for this year's outdoor fun! The bike tour will take us from the Hotel Colorado to the scenic path along the Colorado River. Our ride will start in town and continue upstream for approximately 5 miles. We will make routine stops to describe different areas of interest in the Canyon. Most of the riding will be on the bike path with maybe a section or two on a gravel road. Eventually we will end up back at the Hotel in town.

If you have a bike and would like to bring it, please do so. If you don't have one or don't want to bring one, we will have rentals arranged through the hotel. The rental rate will be about \$18 for the full day and \$13 for a half day. The half-day rental for the conference should be adequate, and CASFM will arrange to pickup the bikes before the trip.
