AN OVERVIEW AND Q&A SESSION ON THE STATE'S PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS

AND

CRS ACTIVITY 430 – HIGHER REGULATORY STANDARDS WORKSHOP

The Colorado Association of Stormwater and Floodplain Managers (CASFM) will be presenting two one-day workshops combining outreach for the proposed revisions to the State's Floodplain Rules and Regulations and training on the Community Rating System (CRS) Activity 430, Higher Regulatory Standards.

The morning session of the workshop will focus on an overview and Q&A session for the revisions to the State's Floodplain Rules and Regulations (Rules) proposed by the Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB). The revisions mark the first time that statewide floodplain management standards are proposed to exceed the minimum standards required by the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The State's Rules are mandatory statewide and it is important for both elected officials and local staff to be aware of these changes and the potential impact these changes could have on administration of local ordinances.

The afternoon session of the workshop will transition into how communities participating in the Community Rating System (CRS) can benefit from implementing higher regulatory standards.

These sessions are intended for local floodplain administrators, elected officials, CRS coordinators, consulting engineers, planners, building officials, public work staff, and anyone else interested or involved in floodplain management.
