How Does Stormwater Affect the Oil & Gas Industry?

Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment has instituted National Pollution Discharge Elimination System Regulations for construction activities associated with the oil & gas industry. In addition, the Clean Water Act requires all oil & gas facilities to minimize sediment from leaving sites of one acre or more. Changing regulations to the oil & gas industry have led to stricter fines and enforcement from the EPA and the CDPHE.
