In order to take the CFM exam, you must complete and submit the CFM Program Application Package to the ASFPM. The forms are available on the ASFPM website www.floods.org under the Certification Program tab. The fee for taking the exam is \$100 for ASFPM members and \$470 for non-members. You may submit an application for ASFPM membership at the same time as applying to take the CFM® exam.

Space in the facility is limited to 50 participants, so get your application in early. In order to be accepted to take the CFM Exam, you must submit your completed application along with the appropriate fee to ASFPM by [April 9, 2020] (2 weeks prior to exam date). No walk-ins will be allowed unless authorized by the ASFPM Executive office.

A Floodplain 101 class will be held on Thursday, April 23rd, 2020. Both the test and the Floodplain 101 class will be held at the same location. For both the class and test, please arrive early enough to locate the facility, check in with the receptionist to gain access, and be settled in. The FP101 class on April 23rd will begin at 8:00 and will conclude at 5:00 pm. The CFM test on April 24th will start at 8:00 am and will conclude at 11:00 am.
