Have You Been Impacted by Flooding or a Wildfire-Induced Natural Disaster?

As stewards of stormwater principles and practices, the Colorado Association of Stormwater and Floodplain Managers (CASFM) supports Colorado citizens, agencies, and public servants in response to flooding and flood related disasters.

This year, we are offering to help the stormwater community and our members, agencies, and citizens who have been affected by natural disasters. We are offering **two \$5,000 donations** for a selected applicant, including (but not exclusive to) community members, local organizations, or agencies who have been negatively impacted by flooding, wildfire disasters, or flood related natural disasters.

About CASFM:

CASFM is an organization of professionals involved in floodplain and stormwater management, water quality, flood hazard mitigation and flood preparedness. CASFM works to reduce the loss of human life and property from flood and storm damage while also improving the environment.

Grant Eligibility:

The grant is available to any community member, organization, or local agency that has experienced flooding or flood-related natural disaster. This could include, but is not exclusive to, degraded water quality, victim of flooding or wildfire, need for restoration, experiencing sedimentation, or need for mitigation.

To Apply:

To apply for the grant, please send a proposal to lisa.lauver@stantec.com. Proposals shall be less than 500 words. The proposal should address the following topics, as applicable.

1. How have you been impacted by flooding or wildfire-related disaster within Colorado?
2. When and where were you impacted by flooding or wildfire-related disaster?
3. How will the funds be specifically used to alleviate your situation?
4. Describe the applicant's experience with managing previous grants or projects of similar size and scope.
