To Apply:

To apply for the grant, please send a research proposal to lisa.lauver@stantec.com. Proposals shall be less than 500 words. The proposal should describe the project, its implementation and goals, and address the following topics, as applicable.

- How does the proposed research/program benefit floodplain or stormwater management?
- How does the proposed research/program advance the protection of human life and property from flooding?
- How does the proposed research/program benefit water quality?
- Will the proposed research/program reach others? Will it educate others or be shared amongst the community?
- Does the proposed research/program benefit Colorado?
- Need for funding What funding resources are being used for the project?

November 10, 2023
